The PPC will serve for a term of three years and will be formally commissioned at the 11.00am Mass on Sunday 27th November, First Sunday of Advent.





CLOSURE OF ULSTER BANK

We recently wrote to parishioners in relation to the imminent closure of Ulster Bank current accounts. As the Parish has been a customer with Ulster Bank, this means that the account that handles your Standing Order will no longer work after this date. We have opened a new account with Bank of Ireland on Main Street, Swords and now ask parishioners to transfer their Standing Orders over to this account.

We thank those who have already signed a Standing Order Form for the new account. We recently sent a new form to other parishioners who have a Standing Order with us and urge them to complete it as soon as possible and return it to the Parish Office. Please remember to cancel your old Ulster Bank standing order. Your support to the Parish through your Standing Order is greatly appreciated.

You will notice that we have installed two new shrine stands at the shrines nearest the sacristy (Sacred Heart and Our Lady). They take a different type of candle, which is more environmentally friendly, as there is practically no waste involved. Once the candle has burned down, it drops through the bottom of the glass container into a pool of water below, where it is extinguished. The company who supply the candles and stands are able to recuperate and reuse the left over candle wax. We invite parishioners to make a donation of 50 cent per candle being lit. We plan in the coming weeks to replace each of the shrine stands.


Crosscare (the diocesan Social Care Agency) thank parishioners for your generous contributions to the annual collection which amounted to €1.212.
