

In less than a week's time, we will go to the polls to elect representatives to the next Dail Eireann, which will hopefully lead to the formation of a new government. In the light of the recent giveaway budget, it is disconcerting to see the various parties outdoing one another with election promises that the Irish Fiscal Advisory Council has previously warned may not be fiscally prudent. It is to be hoped that the electorate may not simply vote for the party or individual that offers the most for their particular sectoral interest but may be guided by what is best for the country as a whole, for vulnerable minorities, for future generations, and for the future of our planet, what the Church in its social teaching refers to as 'the common good'.

This Sunday we celebrate the feast of Christ as universal King, which marks the last Sunday of the liturgical year. Next Sunday we will enter the season of Advent, the start of the church year, and like any new year, it's a good time to review and make adjustments. The parish liturgy group has decided to work on two enhancements to the liturgy as follows. There will be a short pause after the first reading and before the psalm, and again after the second reading and before the Gospel acclamation. This is to allow all of us to pause, reflect and digest what we have just heard in the Word of God. The second change is that when the Ministers of the Eucharist come forward before Communion, they bow to the altar, which is the focal point for the celebration of the Eucharist, where the bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Christ. Advent is a short season, which invites us into a reflective space as the days get shorter and the light of the old year fades, so as to prepare for something new to come to birth in ourselves. Maybe this is a good time to decide to do something a little different, like take part in the reflective reading of the Advent Sunday readings, which will begin this Monday. 'Behold, I stand at the door and knock' (Rev. 3:20)
