

Schools are back and car park restrictions will come back into force. This is the third year that the barriers have been in place and it has made a significant difference to the safety of all using the car park especially the children. It's important that we all respect the opening and closing times as we have to share this car park with so many people. A problem that sometimes happens is that people pull into the barrier and wait for it to open which causes a tail-back on the road. An even more serious problem is that of tailgating ie. slipping in behind the person in front of you when the barrier goes up. This is highly dangerous as people are not concentrating on what's in front of them and often drive faster than what is acceptable. We ask you to please stop this practice. The times barrier closes at 8:40am and reopens 9:20am and for this week it will close at 11:40am and reopen at 12:20pm and then finally it closes at 1:15pm and reopens 3:00pm. The barriers close at 10pm and reopen at 7am.



Eucharistic Adoration

In the article that appeared in last weeks newsletter, Prayer before the Blessed Sacrament was described as a 'Eucharistic cult'. The word 'cult' in our time has very negative overtones and is often associated with the extremist forms of worship and faith that take away the persons free response. This is not what the phrase 'Eucharistic cult' means. In the context of the article from the Directory on Popular Piety and Liturgy, it means a common form of prayer that is part of the Church's rich tradition of devotions. The article shows the important place that Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament has in the life of the Church and indeed in the life of our Parish. 'This worship of adoration has a sound and firm foundation, especially since faith in the Lord's real presence has as its natural consequence the outward and quite public manifestation.' While the phrase may have been disturbing it is good to stop and think about how we pray and out of this to see the real beauty and power of spending time at Eucharistic Adoration.
