

Beatification of Fr John Sullivan SJ



John Sullivan SJ beatified at 11.00am this Saturday 13 May in Gardiner Street Church. The principal celebrant and homilist, representing Pope Francis, will be Cardinal Angelo Amato, Prefect of the Congregation for the Causes of Saints, he will be assisted by the Archbishop of Dublin, Diarmuid Martin. Also present will be The Church of Ireland Archbishop of Dublin, Michael Jackson. Please note that the capacity of Gardiner St Church is quite limited. Unfortunately, there can be no guarantee that everyone who comes to the church will gain entrance. For this reason, the Jesuits have set up two marquees in the Church's back garden, where a live broadcast of the event will be made available. This broadcast will also be viewable in Belvedere College, in nearby Great Denmark Street. People at home and abroad can also watch the entire ceremony live, on the Irish Jesuit website at www.jesuit.ie/beatification.
