## he Sacrament of Confession is available on Saturday mornings from 10:45am to 12:00noon. One of the things that we have to avoid during the restrictions is crowds gathering while waiting on Sacraments.

We want to be able to continue to provide Confession so we need your help, understanding and co-operation. The Confession time will be 5 fifteen minute slots. In each fifteen minutes there will be room for five people for Confession.

A sheet inside the Main door is where you can reserve a place in the fifteen minute slots by putting your initials. You can only be in the Church during the 15 min slot as you wait on the bench nearest the Pastoral Centre. Please do not wait around the Church and only come in at the beginning of the 15 minute slot you reserve. There will be a steward in the Church to guide people.

We ask those who have recently received a CHY Tax Reclaim form to return it to the Parish Office as soon as possible.
