In the next few weeks, the Sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated here in the Parish. As the young people enter into the final stages of preparation, they will take part in the Service of Light.

At their child's baptism parents light the baptismal candle from the paschal candle, this is a sign that they are willing to hand on their faith to their child. In the same way, at the

service of light, parents once again light their child's baptismal candle from the paschal candle and hand the lighted candle to their children; in doing so parents promise to help and support their child live out the call of their Confirmation. They are agreeing, together with their child, to keep the light of faith burning in all of their lives. The children are also asked to make a promise not to drink alcohol until they are 18, and to never take or handle dangerous drugs.

THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

will be celebrated on Thursday, February 14th & Friday February 15th. On both of those days, Morning Mass will be celebrated at 9am. The car park will close at 9.30am and will not re-open until after the Schools close.

Please pray for the young people at this important time in their lives as they approach the Sacrament of Confirmation. May they be filled with the gifts of the Holy Spirit.
