We have just entered the month of August, and we are still in holiday mode, with many people either away or preparing to go away.

Summer is a vital time for changing rhythm, having more time with



family and friends, reconnecting with nature and recharging the batteries. It is a time too when farmers prepare for the harvest. August, however, also signals the approach of the new school year. Parents are organising school uniforms or registering their children for sacraments. Other people may be setting out on new paths: a new job, secondary school, college, or going abroad to work or study. It is all about preparing, being ready. This is the call at the heart of this Sunday's Gospel: 'See that you are dressed for action and have your lamps lit'. As people of faith, we are invited to be clear about what we are about, to have a focus. This means taking time to nourish our faith: through prayer, reflection and reading of scripture or some form of spiritual reading, and perhaps through some kind of parish involvement or ministry, so that we grow in our relationship with Christ and become a beacon of hope for others. 'For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.'

Godly Play Ireland in partnership with the Mater Dei Centre for Catholic Education, is offering a Commuter Core Training course in Dublin.

Core Commuter training consists of three days training to take place over three Saturdays in September, October and November. It offers the opportunity to develop your practice and understanding of the art of Godly Play.

There will be a mixture of facilitator-led presentations together with participant storytelling presentations. Each Saturday explores one of the primary genres of Godly Play: Sacred Stories, Parables and Liturgical Lessons.

Workshops also cover details of how to set up a Godly Play environment, the theology and spirituality of childhood, and time to explore your concerns and questions.

This commuter model underscores the action/reflection aspect of Godly Play training by allowing participants new experiences between training dates, which they then bring with them to the next Commuter Core module.
