Palm Sunday

Mass with the Blessing of Palm at 6:30pm on Saturday 27th March. We will welcome the children who are preparing for their First Holy Communion to participate in this Mass.

Palm Sunday Mass at 9:00am and 11:00am. Palms will be blessed at the beginning of Mass.



The Chrism Mass takes place on Wednesday evening at 7:30pm in St. Mary's Pro-Cathedral. During the Mass the Holy Oils to be used in the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, Ordination and Anointing the Sick will be blessed and the Holy Chrism consecrated. During this Mass the Priests of the Diocese renew their Priestly commitment of service. We invite you to join us for the Mass streamed on www.procathedral.ie and pray for our Priests and all who will receive the Sacraments this year.



Good Friday

Morning Prayer at 10:00am (text is in your Lenten Pack)

Passion and Veneration of the Cross at 3:00pm. We invite you to use the Palm Cross from your pack or any cross you have at home to kiss during the veneration.

Stations of the Cross will take place from 6:00pm around the Parish. We ask you not to gather at the Prayer Stations but to stand at your door or gate at the time of prayers in your estate and if you live on the route we will take, please stand out as we pass by.

Prayer Around the Cross at 9:00pm. When the Stations are complete we will have our Friday Taizé Prayer remembering all the people of the Parish and their intentions.
