

Blessing and Opening of St. Cronan's Pastoral Centre Format of the Day

Earlier this month we held an open meeting to hear from people the way that we should mark this important event in our Parish. From the discussions that took place the Parish Pastoral Council took the ideas and shaped them as follows:

Mass will take place at 12:30pm on Sunday 5th June.

We welcome all help with a clean-up of the Parish Centre, Church & grounds both inside and out on Saturday 4th June at 12 noon.

There will be NO 11:00 am Mass on that Sunday

Both Choirs and our Saturday night cantor will lead the music.

The Scouts and Order of Malta will form a colour party.

In the opening procession the name plaques for the various rooms in the Pastoral Centre will be placed in the sacred space.

The Prayer of the Faithful will be read in the various languages of the Parish.

After Mass a procession will lead Archbishop Martin to the Pastoral Centre.

He will unveil the plaque in the porch and proceed into the Centre for the Prayer of Blessing.

There will be a sound link for people in the Church to hear the ceremony.

In the Pastoral Centre there will be people gathered representing the various groups in the Parish and the various groups that use the Pastoral Centre. Among them a group of twenty who will be drawn by lottery from the buy-a-brick certificates. The Parish Pastoral Council, the Pastoral Centre Development Group and Pastoral Centre Management Committee will also be there.

After the Blessing the Archbishop will be presented with a History of the Parish.

Refreshments will be served for everybody in the Pastoral Centre and the Scouts will have their famous bar-b-que sausages in the Pastoral Centre Garden.

While some people have been received an invitation due to their role in the ceremony or their association with the Parish, the invitation that has been in the Newsletter over the past weeks is the invitation to all our Parishioners and Friends.



NORLD MEETING OF FAMILIES DUBLIN 2018

22nd—26th August 2018

The Archdiocese of Dublin is the host diocese for this event which takes place once every three years in different parts of the world. The principal events of the World Meeting of Families 2018 will be held in Dublin, but events will also take place in other centres around Ireland.

Why does Pope Francis consider the family so important?

- The welfare of the family is decisive for the future of the world and that of the Church
- The experience of love in families is a perennial source of strength for the life of the Church
- The family is like a factory of hope
- God likes most to knock on the doors of families and to find families that are united, that love each other and that raise their children in view of creating a society of truth, goodness and beauty

What is the World Meeting of Families?

In 1994, Pope St. John Paul II asked the Pontifical Council for the Family to establish the World Meeting of Families as an international event of prayer, catechesis and celebration, drawing participants from around the globe. It seeks to strengthen the bonds between families and to bear witness to the crucial importance of marriage and the family for all of society. The World Meeting of Families also fosters gestures of solidarity for families in difficulty.
