been chaplain for a number of years to a team of married couples who meet monthly for fellowship and support and to deepen their relationship with Christ and their understanding of the vocation of marriage. There are approximately 35 such teams spread across Ireland north and south, but for the 18 or so of us who came to Turin, it is our first time attending an international gathering which takes place every 6 years.

The focus of the gathering is encounter, learning, sharing and celebration. The theme of the gathering, *Let us go with a burning*

Heart, was inspired by the Road to Emmaus story in Luke, and each day's theme echoed a particular moment in that story as well as reflecting the structure of the Mass. Each morning, along with one or two formal presentations, one or two couples from different parts of the world shared with remarkable honesty and courage their experience of trying to live the commitment of marriage and the support they have received from Teams. Each evening scattered across Turin in different hotels, we met in groups after supper to reflect on what we had heard that morning and how it touched our own lives. It was both a humbling and uplifting

REGISTRATION FOR RELIGION CLASSES:

Parents of children attending Swords or Thornleigh Educate Together or Broadmeadows Community National Schools, who would like their children to celebrate the sacraments of either First Communion or Confirmation, are also invited to register their children separately on our website for religion classes, which begin on a weekly basis in September. The preparation Thur Marie McHugh (RD) classes for each sacrament run over a two year basis, Fri regardless of which class the child is attending in Sat primary school. The cost per child per year for the religion classes is €150, which covers the remuneration of teachers, hiring of rooms and course materials. This should be paid using the Donate button on the website.

We now have a group of over 30 people booked to take part in our partnership of parishes Pilgrimage to Lourdes from Sunday 15th Thursday 19th September. Anyone still interested in taking part in our pilgrimage is urged to book directly with Marian Pilgrimages in the coming days. The cost of the pilgrimage for four nights and five days (inclusive of flights, accommodation and full board) is €735 per person sharing. A limited number of single rooms are available, at a single supplement of €40 per night. Booking forms are available at the parish office.
