#### Emmanuel: God-With-Us

What does it mean for us that God is with us? What difference does it make that in Jesus, God has walked among us, understood the sorrow and joy of our life, the things that hold us back and the things that draw out the very best in us?

A part of the reality of what Christmas means gets lost in the beautiful image of the crib. Yet for God to enter into our lives he had to come into the world the same way that we do. But the message grows and doesn't stay stuck in this moment. When you look at all the things that are associated with the birth in the crib there are so many things which show that the God-with-us is a challenging reality.

The stable was a place of compromise because there was no room in the inn. The Shepherds were a group that wasn't trusted by people, yet they are the first to worship this new born king. The Kings carry three gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. It points to the way that he will accomplish his kingdom through suffering and death.

Emmanuel, God-with-us, is one who touches the parts of our lives that we hide away, that we can be ashamed of, that isolate us. Emmanuel, God-with-us, goes into the messy parts of our lives. Emmanuel, God-with-us, reaches out to those who are on the outside, excluded, abandoned. Emmanuel, wants to be God-with-us. Do you want him to be with you?



#### **Brackenstown Bible Study 2017**

During 2016 we ran two very informative and enjoyable Scripture study courses. In spring we followed Jeff Cavins 8 week DVD study "Unlocking the Mystery of the Bible". In the autumn we completed Jeff Cavins 13 week "The Bible Timeline Reading Plan"

During 2017 we will study Jeff Cavins 23 week DVD course "The Bible Timeline; The Story of Salvation" The course will consist of 12 classes in the spring and 11 classes in the autumn. This is the foundational study in *The Great Adventure* Bible Study Series that has


