Last Monday, in his homily for the Feast of St. Kevin of Glendalough, Archbishop Dermot announced that he is asking Pope Francis to designate St. Mary's Pro-Cathedral as a Cathedral, as part of a renewed pastoral and missionary strategy, that would see St. Mary's and St. Andrew's Church Westland Row serving as twin pillars for the celebration of Catholic liturgical, pastoral and cultural life in the heart of Dublin city.
